

Signs and Symptoms of Labor

For our obstetrical patients over 36 weeks

Please call us immediately if any of the following occur:

1. Regular contractions occurring 3-5 minutes apart, lasting 30-45 seconds each. Please call when the contractions have been going on at this regular interval for at least an hour.
2. Any heavy bleeding which is more than bloody mucus or light-colored spotting at any time in your pregnancy.
3. If your water breaks and there is continuous leakage of fluid of any color or a gush of fluid from the vagina
4. Persistent, severe abdominal pain
5. Decreased fetal movement with less than 6 movements from your baby in an hour
